PAPER SUBMISSION

For papers submissions (both initial and final) please, use upload service at <http://inforino.mpei.ru/submission>.

- Initial paper should be submitted in a PDF format (do not use PDF-eXpress service on that stage). The information on the authors should be excluded from the initially submitted file for peer review process.
- Each paper should be **4 to 6 pages long** and should **meet the IEEE manuscript requirements**. Two additional pages can be submitted for extra 20 USD per page.
- The working languages of the conference are English and Russian. Papers for IEEE Xplore are accepted in English only
- Accepted papers **presented at oral or poster sessions** will be submitted to **IEEE Xplore** database to be cross-referred in Scopus and Web of Science.
